He served honorably for 30 years with the Tulsa Police. Jack was a great family man, husband, father and grandfather. He enjoyed spending time with his family hunting, fishing, and camping. As a professional flight instructor, he loved taking his family on outings in airplanes as often as he could. There was no person he loved more than his beloved wife Dianne. They had a wonderful marriage of 62 years. He led by example in every aspect of his life and he will be dearly missed.
